Communicability and information availability on a University homepage

Region: Americas

TOP 100

University Homepage (English version) is a global source of public information on the achievements of the university and its capabilities, about quality and level of education, research and communications.

Experts: members of the International Council of Scientists.

Evaluation of availability of information was conducted in following categories (a total of 52 indicators):

- General information, university description – 13 indicators;
- Campuses - amenities and capabilities – 6 indicators;
- Information for university community – 8 indicators;
- Academic information (learning) – 9 indicators;
- Academic information (research) – 8 indicators;
- Communication possibilities – 8 indicators.

Calculations take into account importance (weight) of each parameter (average values) that in turn is being assessed by 10 point scale. Average values of parameters are determined as a result of a survey conducted among members of the International Council of Scientists.

World classification by class:

- a+** – universities with the value of the BC-Index of at least 80 % of the maximum possible;
- a** – universities with the value of the BC-Index of at least 75 % of the maximum possible;
- a-** – universities with the value of the BC-Index of at least 70 % of the maximum possible;
- b+** – universities with the value of the BC-Index of at least 65 % of the maximum possible;
- b** – universities with the value of the BC-Index of at least 55 % of the maximum possible;
- b-** – universities with the value of the BC-Index of less than 55 % but more 40 % of the maximum possible.
